

Austin Independent School District Student Transfers 2009 – 2010

Majority-to-Minority Transfer

Students may transfer from a school where the student's ethnic group is more than 50 percent of the school's population to a school where the student's ethnic group is less than 50 percent of the school's population. The purpose of the majority-to minority transfer is to complement the District's student assignments and promote diversity throughout the District. Majority-to-minority transfers will be granted if the request is submitted by the priority deadline of February 20, 2009. To receive priority consideration for a majority-to-minority transfer, two ethnic groups are defined:

- Black (and not of Hispanic origin) and Hispanic students.
- American Indian/Alaskan Native, Asian/Pacific Islander and White (and not of Hispanic origin) students.
