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Goals

Goal 1: Student Well Being & Achievement

Lyndon Baines Johnson Early College High School will provide rigorous and engaging real-world learning opportunities so that our students can achieve academically.

Performance Objective 1: Based on the 2023-2024 preliminary tables for LBJ ECHS, the percentage of all students scoring at the approaching level on the STAAR EOC English I test was 12.9% with16.7% meeting standard and 2.7% mastering standard. By June 2025, a minimum of 70% of all students will perform at the approaching level and a minimum of 55% at meets and above.

Performance Objective 2: Based on the 2023-2024 preliminary tables for LBJ ECHS, the percentage of all students scoring at the approaching level on the STAAR EOC English II test was 16% with 23.8% meeting standard and .4% mastering standard. By June 2025, a minimum of 70% of all students will perform at the approaching level and a minimum of 55% at meets and above.

Performance Objective 3: Based on the 2024-2025 preliminary tables for LBJ ECHS, the percentage of all students scoring at the approaching level on the STAAR EOC Algebra I test was 38.7% with 3.4% meeting standard and .4% mastering standard. By June 2024, a minimum of 70% of all students will perform at the approaching level and a minimum of 55% at meets and above.

Performance Objective 4: Based on the 2023-2024 preliminary tables for LBJ ECHS, the percentage of all students scoring at the approaching level on the STAAR EOC Biology I test was 50.2% with 24.4% meeting standard and 2% mastering standard. By June 2025, a minimum of 80% of all students will perform at the approaching level and a minimum of 55% at meets and above.

Performance Objective 5: Based on the 2023-2024 preliminary tables for LBJ ECHS, the percentage of all students scoring at the approaching level on the STAAR EOC US History test was 37% with 32% meeting standard and 23% mastering standard. By June 2025, a minimum of 96% of all students will perform at the approaching level and a minimum of 60% at meets and above.
