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Goals

Goal 1: Student Well-Being & Achievement

Performance Objective 1: Goal 1 - Students identified as economically disadvantaged demonstrating achievement on 3rd grade state assessment in reading at the Meets Grade Level will increase from 51% to 60% by August 2026.
