 - Staff retention: 20% increase in teacher retention over the last 2 years.
 - Welcomed over 700 new employees at Teacher Induction Program (200 less than last year)
 - Less than 1% difference in retention rate between non-Title I vs. Title I campuses
 - This year we are introducing "Rolling TIP" weekly onboarding sessions for teachers who
