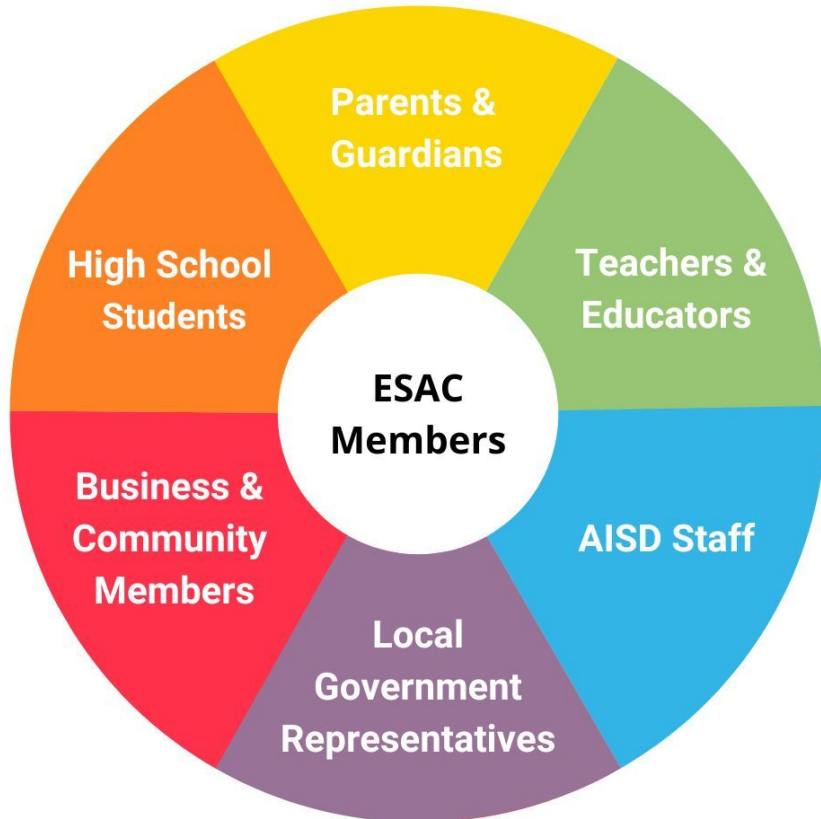

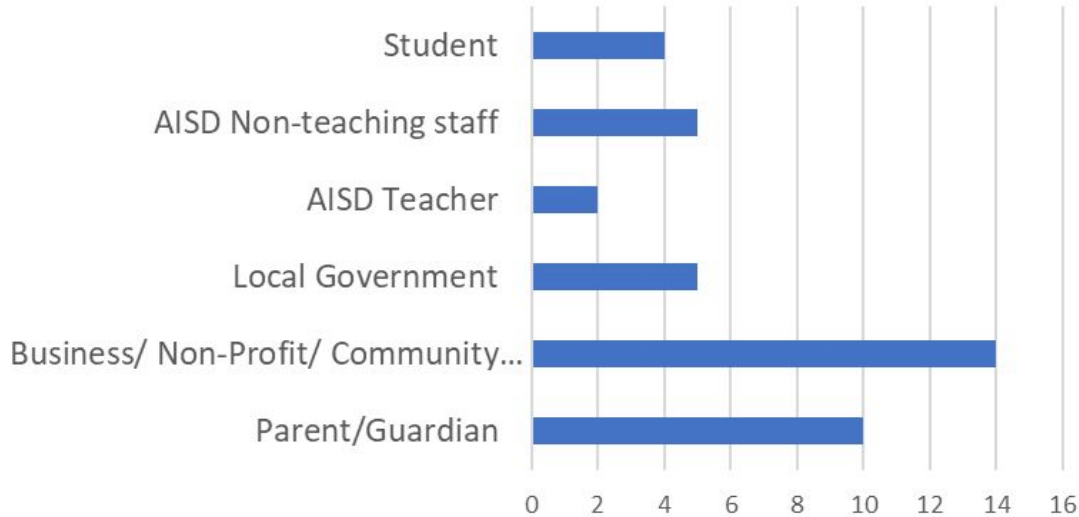

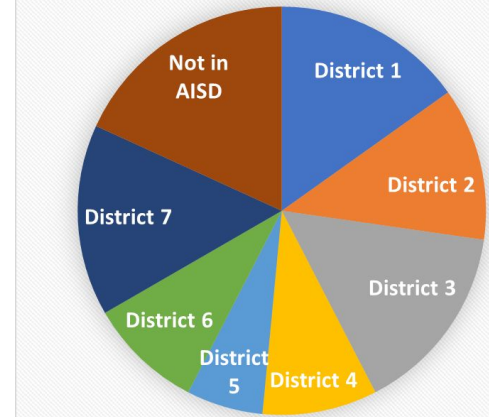

Voting Members by category, cumulative



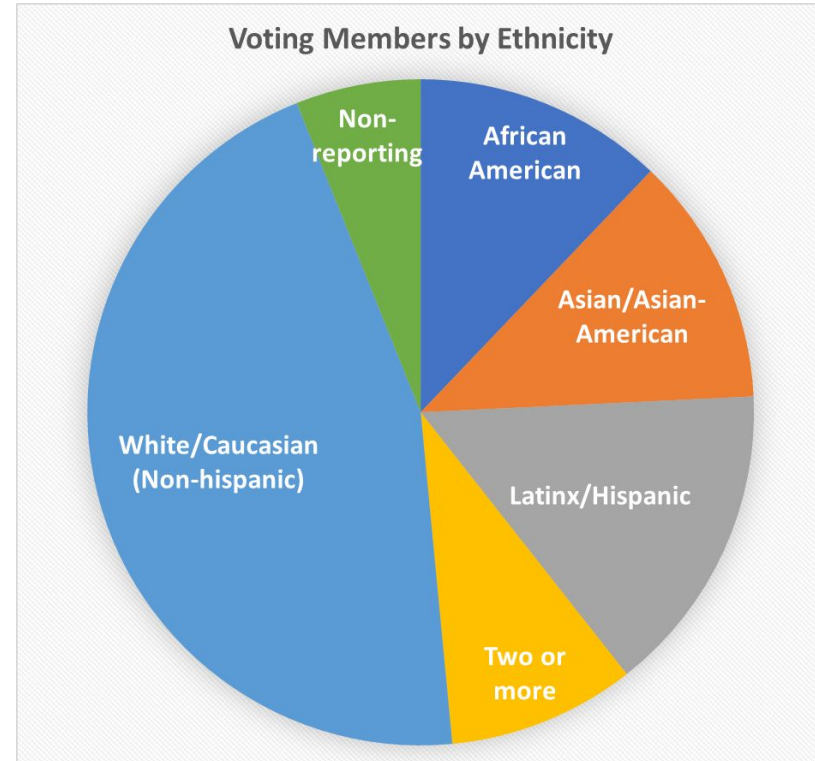
Votng Members by Trustee District

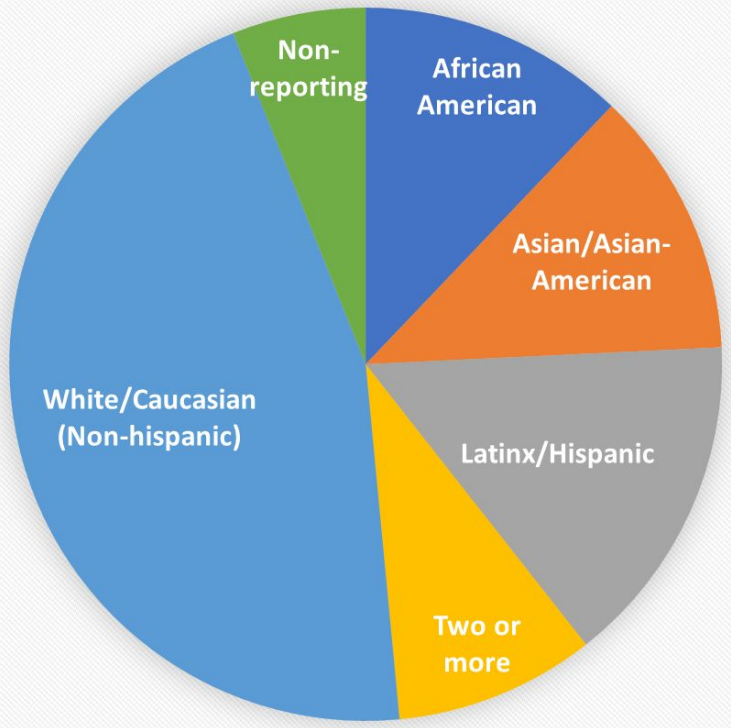

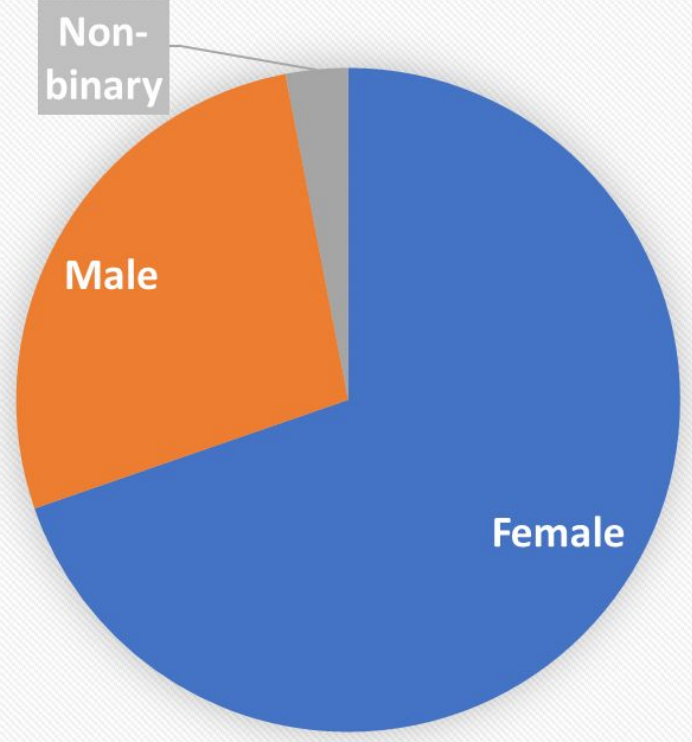


SY 2024-2025 Members

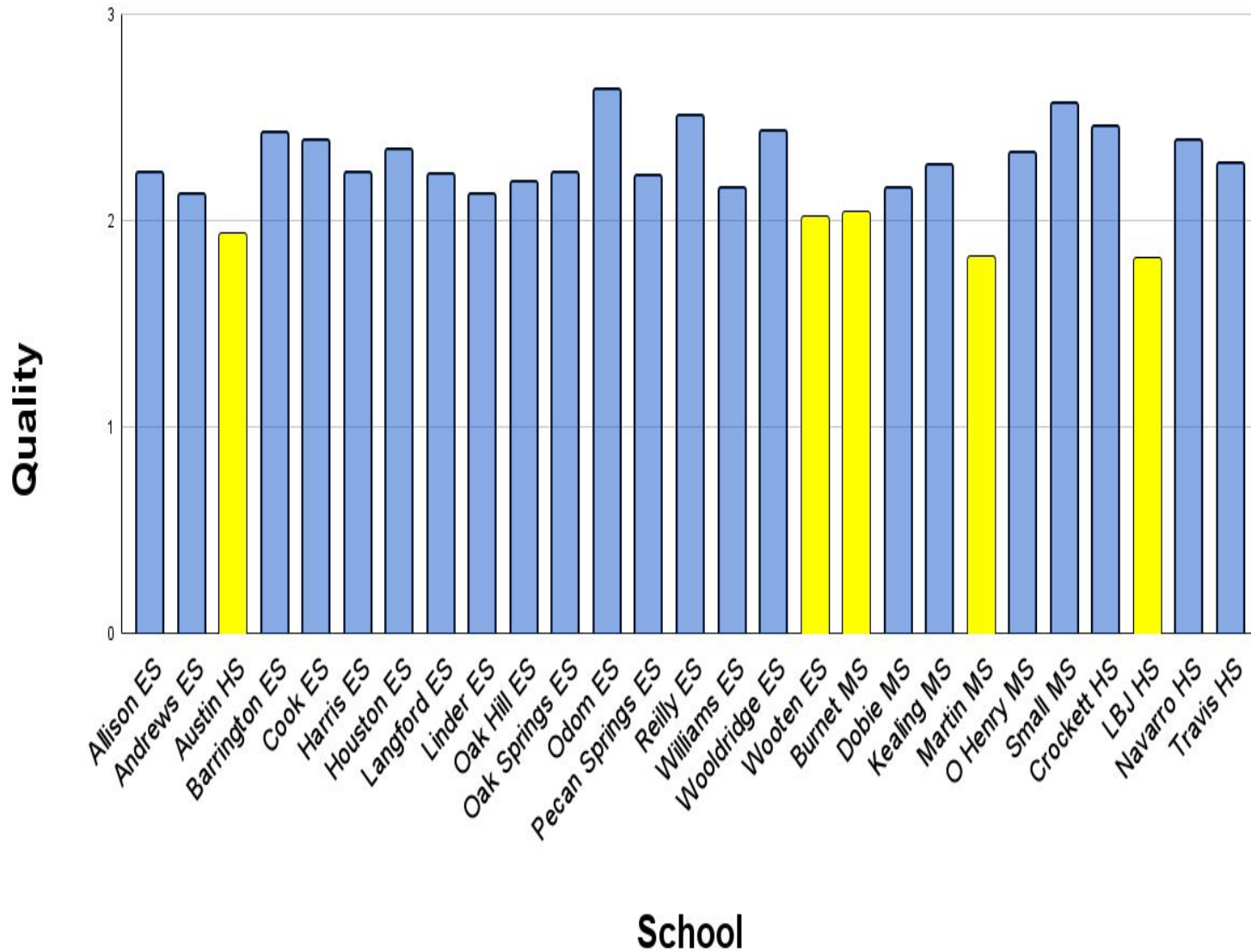
