

PURPOSE

AISD Department of Program Evaluation (DPE) staff examined the mobility of AISD students enrolled prekindergarten (pre-K) in 2009–2010 to determine the percentage of students who did not attend kindergarten in the district in 2010–2011 (i.e., those who left the district).

METHODOLOGY

DPE staff used the Public Education Information Management System (PEIMS) attendance records to establish all students enrolled in the pre-K program during 2009–2010. Those records were compared to the Fall 2010 PEIMS snapshot for the 2010–2011 school year. Students who were not enrolled at any AISD campus on the snapshot date were assumed to have left the district.¹

2009–2010 PRE-K STUDENTS' ENROLLMENT IN 2010–2011 BY VERTICAL TEAM

Of the 5,445 pre-K students enrolled in AISD during 2009–2010, 82% ($n = 4,459$) were enrolled at an AISD campus for kindergarten in Fall 2010. The rates varied by vertical team (Table 1) and school (Table 2). The elementary schools in the Reagan vertical team had the 3rd highest percentage of pre-K students leaving the district (20%) and the highest number of pre-K students leaving the district ($n = 162$). The elementary schools in the LBJ vertical team had the second highest percentage (21%) and number of pre-K students ($n = 157$) leaving the district. The elementary schools in the Travis vertical team had the third highest pre-K enrollment in the district in 2009–2010 ($n = 702$) and had the fewest percentage of students leave the district for kindergarten (14.7%).

Key Findings

- 18% of the 2009–2010 AISD pre-K students ($n = 986$) left AISD for kindergarten for the 2010–2011 year.
- 20% of pre-K students who were enrolled at an elementary school in the Reagan vertical team did not enroll in AISD during the 2010–2011 year (i.e., 162 left the district for kindergarten).

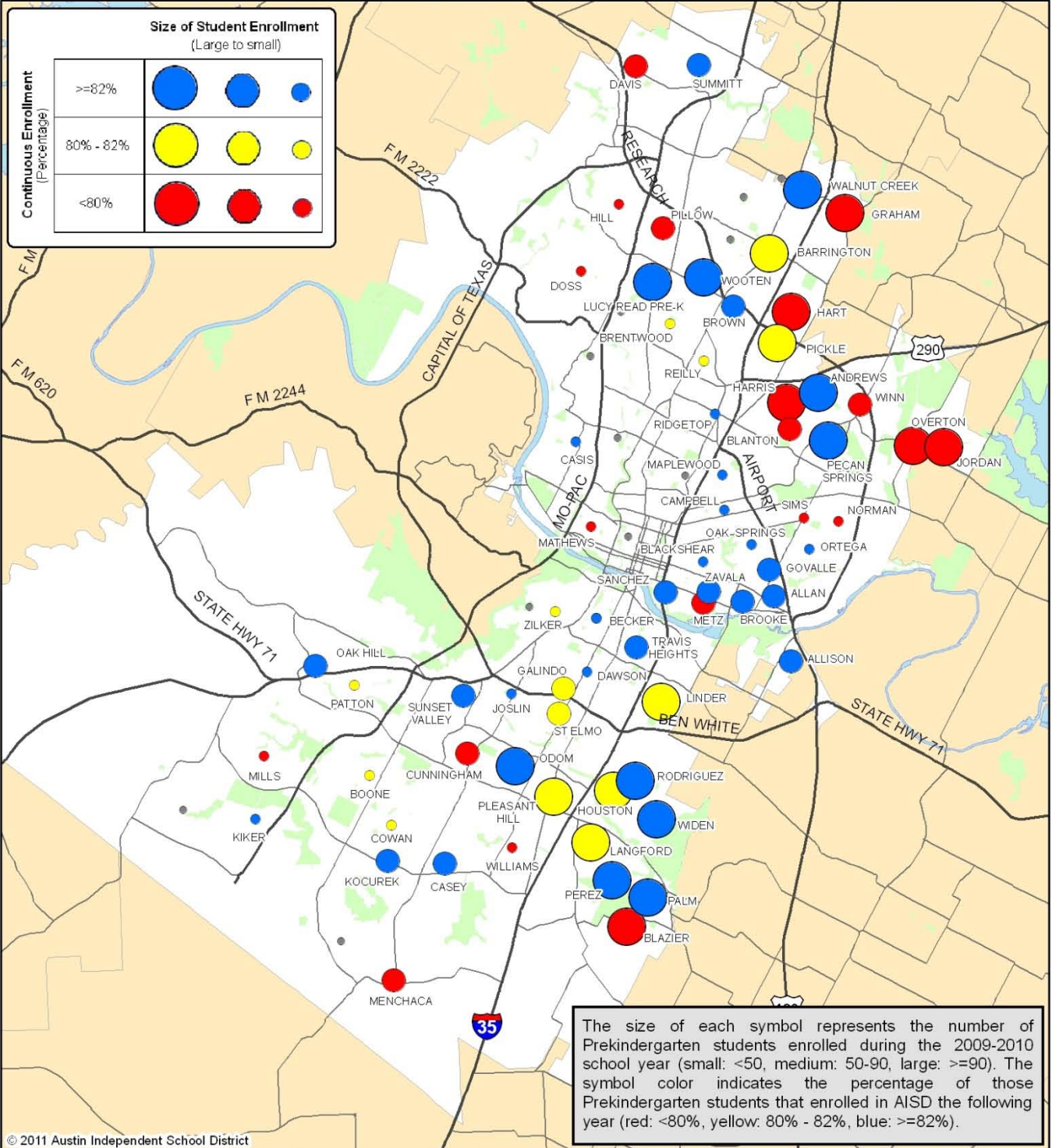
