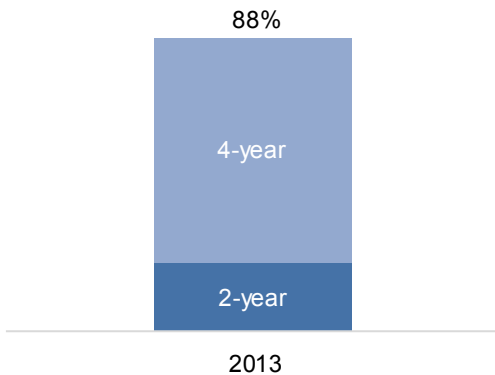

of **economically disadvantaged** graduates enrolled in

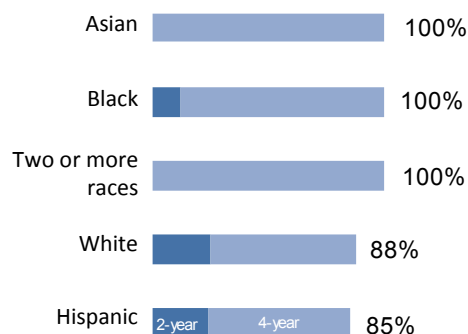
